Students must successfully complete at least 24 credits to meet Standard Diploma requirements. Students must also have at least a 2.0 GPA, receive passing scores on appropriate EOCs, receive a passing score on 10th grade FSA in Reading, and complete an online course in order to graduate. Students are encouraged to complete the online credit the summer before freshmen year. Suggested courses: Psychology, Sociology, Personal Fitness, Fitness Lifestyle Design, Outdoor Education, Personal and Family Finances, Social Media, Peer Counseling, Critical Thinking and Study Skills, and Driver Education. **Middle school counselors recommend and approve online courses.**
